## PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST OBJECTIVES

- To provide middle and high school age youth with an opportunity to gain a greater understanding of how agriculture impacts their lives daily and creates job opportunities within their communities.
- To provide a medium for youth to visually show their interest in the bounty produced by American agriculture.
- To provide youth with an opportunity to document Harnett County surroundings impacting Farm-City connections.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

♦ Open to all middle and high school age youth grades 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>.

#### REGULATIONS

- The photograph must follow the Farm-City Week theme. "Women in Agriculture"
- Photos submitted must be in print form no larger than 8x10. 4x6 prints are acceptable.
- All submissions must include the photo uploaded online at http://go.ncsu.edu/2017farmcityphotocontest. You can also use the QR code below to access the link to upload your photo online. Entries received without this component will not be eligible for prizes.
- All photo submissions must include the Farm-City Week Contest Entry Form with required information.
- The photo must be the original work of the youth and taken in 2017. Limit of one entry per youth.
