



**NC State 4-H Horse Shows**  
**COVID-19 Guidelines**  
***Know Before You Show***

***These guidelines are established by North Carolina State University and must be adhered to for this event. Any individual not in compliance with these standards will not be permitted to participate. Please also note that these guidelines are subject to change based on current NC and NCSU policies.***

- No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID- 19, or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14-days, or positive test results for COVID-19 is permitted at the event.
- All individuals that enter the grounds will be required to pass a daily temperature screening and display proof of completing them (such as a wrist band provided by show management). If you are camping on the grounds, you will still need to get your temperature checked daily at the designated location by show management.
- Masks **MUST** be worn by **ALL** persons on the show grounds at **ALL** times unless mounted on a horse. Masks must be worn by exhibitors for showmanship, ground handling, and halter classes where the exhibitor is unmounted. We understand that many horse shows have this requirement but do not enforce this. *As this is a registered North Carolina State University event, this guideline must be followed and will be enforced. We appreciate your cooperation.*
- Each competitor may only have one person attending them in the warm up area, schooling area, and at the in gate.
- Spectators outside of the immediate support staff for the youth (family, trainer/instructor, 4-H agent) are discouraged at this time. The main arena will be broadcast live via Facebook for other spectators to be able to watch.

## Class list foot notes:

### \*Indicates non-qualifying class for the State 4-H Horse Show

**\*\*Trail classes will run on an open card from 9am to 1pm in the arena up on the hill above the covered arena.**

- 1 = Exhibitors 13 years of age or younger.
- 2 = English and western show together.
- 3 = Cloverbud classes are for youth who are between the ages of 5 and 7 as of January 1 of the current year. **No cantering** allowed in Cloverbud classes. All Cloverbuds receive blue ribbons. Cloverbuds may **not** enter non-Cloverbud classes.
- 4 = Horses and ponies compete in the same class.
- 5 = Juniors and seniors show together.
- 6 = To be eligible for Adaptive Rider classes, exhibitors must meet the requirements in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules & Regulations.
- 7= Canter not allowed.
- 8= Only open to Saddle seat Trotting breeds.
- 9= Open only to non-trotting breeds.
- 10= English non-trotting (2 gaits) classes 520, 521 cannot cross enter into class 519 and vice versa.
- 11= Walking, Racking, Spotted Saddle horses are ineligible for this class.
- 12= Non Trotting breeds division entries may only enter one pleasure class.

*Classes may run at the same time in the same or different arenas. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of where and when their class is being held.*

## Minimum / Maximum Fence Height Ranges:

### Equitation over Fences:

Large Pony: Min 2'3" / Max 2'6"

Medium Pony: Min 2' / Max 2'3"

Small Pony: 2'

Short Stirrup: 2'

Long Stirrup: 2'

Low Working Hunter: 2'3"

Working Hunter: 2'6"-2'9"

\*\*\*\*\*

Effective 1/1/2010 the NC 4-H Horse Program requires ALL riders to wear protective headgear that meets or surpasses current ASTM/SEI standards while riding during any 4-H Horse Program sponsored event or activity. Headgear must be properly fitted, worn on the top of the head, and with the harness securely fastened.

## Age Divisions:

Rookie: Riders must be in their first year showing hunt seat at the 4-H level as a junior or higher division. The intention of this division is to serve as a safe introductory experience for hunt seat.

Short Stirrup are hunt seat classes open to youth ages 8 to 13. 3 years of participation is allowed with no more than 2 years of showing over fences. Division is designed for inexperienced juniors. May not cross enter into other hunter divisions.

Long Stirrup are hunt seat classes open to youth ages 14 and up.

Two years of participation is allowed. Participants may not have previously shown over fences for more than 2 years.

Little Britches are western classes open to youths, ages 8 to 13, who are in their first two years of showing. Division is designed for inexperienced juniors. May not cross-enter into other western divisions.

Junior Rider classes are open to those youths who have not reached age 14 before January 1 of the current year.

Senior Rider classes are open only to those youths who have reached age 14 as of January 1 of the current year and who have not reached age 19 as of January 1 of the current year

\*\*\*\*\*

Adults are prohibited from riding a horse unless it has become DANGEROUS for the youth to do so. An adult riding a horse must be cleared with the show office before the adult mounts the horse. Failure to do this will result in disqualification of the horse.

\*\*\*\*\*

All horses on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Once a show official verifies a horse's Coggins the exhibitor will be given a card allowing them to pick up their show packet. Coggins must be posted outside horse's stall or trailer at all times for inspection by the state vet. Fines for Coggins violations will be passed onto the exhibitor.

\*\*\*\*\*

Show management reserves the right to adjust the schedule as needed to address safety concerns.

\*\*\*\*\*

Ponies in Jr/Sr Hunter and Western pony classes must be measured at the show unless they have a USEF or NCHJA Permanent Pony Card. Measurements will be done on Friday afternoon.

## NC 4-H Horse Program Rule I-F.27. Finality of Decisions

The decision of the judge is final. All horses and ponies cannot win, so the judge's decision, on whatever it may be, should be accepted in the true spirit of sportsmanship and 4-H membership. When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parent, leader, or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's rights to participate in future classes or shows for such period as judged appropriate. The exhibitor's parent, leader, friend, or agent can and will be barred from the show grounds for unsportsmanlike conduct or improper behavior.

### Protests:I-G.2.Form

A verbal protest, accompanied with \$50 cash, must be filed with the paddock coordinator by the complaining party within the time the protested class is announced or until the gate is closed for the next class, whichever comes first. A written protest must be submitted within 15 minutes. If the appeals committee upholds the protest, the deposit will be refunded. If the protest is overruled, the deposit shall be forfeited to the N.C. 4-H Horse Program Fund.

State 4-H Horse Show dressage packets will be available at the show office during the qualifying show.

\*\*\*\*\*

Exhibitors qualifying for the State 4-H Horse Show must pick their packets up at the show office during the 4-H Qualifying Horse Show. State entries are due 10 days after the qualifying show.

\*\*\*\*\*

Each exhibitor and horse must earn one or more qualifying points in a division at the 4-H Qualifying Horse Show in order to be eligible to participate in that division at the State 4-H Horse Show.
