

NC State 4-H Horse Shows COVID-19 Guidelines Know Before You Show

These guidelines are established by North Carolina State University and must be adhered to for this event. Any individual not in compliance with these standards will not be permitted to participate. Please also note that these guidelines are subject to change based on current NC and NCSU policies.

- No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19, or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14-days, or positive test results for COVID-19 is permitted at the event.
- All individuals that enter the grounds will be required to pass a daily temperature screening and display
 proof of completing them (such as a wrist band provided by show management). If you are camping on
 the grounds, you will still need to get your temperature checked daily at the designated location by
 show management.
- Masks MUST be worn by ALL persons on the show grounds at ALL times unless mounted on a horse.
 Masks must be worn by exhibitors for showmanship, ground handling, and halter classes where the
 exhibitor is unmounted. We understand that many horse shows have this requirement but do not
 enforce this. As this is a registered North Carolina State University event, this guideline must be
 followed and will be enforced. We appreciate your cooperation.
- Each competitor may only have one person attending them in the warm up area, schooling area, and at the in gate.
- Spectators outside of the immediate support staff for the youth (family, trainer/instructor, 4-H agent)
 are discouraged at this time. The main arena will be broadcast live via Facebook for other spectators to
 be able to watch.

It is the responsibility of all Parents, Leaders, and 4-H'ers, to be aware of any rule changes that may affect them.

- ---Remember the SC District 4-H Horse Show Committee reserves the right to make changes in the class schedule if needed. (ie. Bad weather, Divisions running behind)
- --- Unfortunately there will be no Miniature Equine Division this year.

Eligibility Card and Coggins

Copies of the Eligibility Card and Coggins must be sent in with entries. However, when checking in at the show, each 4-H member must show the original eligibility card, which has been signed by their Leader and County Extension Agent, plus an ORIGINAL of your horse's

negative Coggins test. The name of the horse on the Coggins and the name of the horse on the Eligibility Card, MUST MATCH!!! The 4-H'er will receive a show number only after review of the Coggins and eligibility card.

All horses must be kept in a stall, if on the grounds overnight.

Ponies

Remember Ponies may present an official USEF or NCHJA measurement card when registering at the office and during check in. If you do not have an official card, you must have your pony measured before registering with the show office.

Note official pony measuring times are

Friday - 1:00PM-6:00PM, Sat. 7:00AM-8:00AM, Sun. 8:00AM -9:00AM

Registering

We encourage each exhibitor to pre-register in ALL classes. Each horse and rider must be registered in at least one class. You will be allowed to add up to five (5) additional classes on site for the entire show. * * * Class additions must be completed a minimum of 3 classes prior start of the class you are entering on each day!!!!. If you need to add one of the first 3 classes on either Saturday or Sunday, those must be added no later than 30min before the start of the show!!! (see show office schedule for times). Classes added must be paid for when added and there will be no refunds on any dropped classes.

Class Scratches/Gate Calls

PLEASE be considerate and let the gate personnel or office know if you are going to scratch a class!!!! There will be no gate calls unless you have requested one with the Show Office.

Refund Policy

Please note that current policy as recommended by the Advisory Board is that no district show fees, including entry, stall, etc. will be refunded if the amount is less than \$25.00. Entries canceled after the deadline date will forfeit their stall fees! A refund form is provided in the packet and must be submitted with the appropriate information.

Check-In and Office Hours

The show grounds will open at 12:00pm on Friday, May 14th. The show office will be open on Friday from 1:00 pm to 6:30 pm for early check-in. However the grounds will remain open until 10 pm for horses hauling in Friday night. If you arrive after the show office has closed, please call Samantha Taylor 704-724-0525 or Amanda Baucom (704-507-3754) to check your Coggins papers before unloading horses. The show office will reopen at 7:00 a.m. Saturday morning, and at 7:30 a.m. Sunday morning for check-in. The show office will remain open for 30 minutes following the completion of the last class of the day. Show packets may be picked up only after the original Coggins and original eligibility cards are checked, and ponies are measured or their official measurement card is checked. There will be someone to assist with parking your trailer and guiding you through the check-in procedure

Bedding

Shavings will be available for sale during the show for \$7.00 per bag, but please preorder at least a minimum amount you will need. You may also bring your own shavings if you prefer to do so. No horse may be stabled on the show grounds without appropriate bedding.

Schooling

Schooling on the flat, and over fences, in the covered arena, will be provided on Friday afternoon. A Google Document will go out a few weeks before the show for sign-up, and there will also be a sign-up sheet in the Show Office on Friday May 14.

Concessions will be available on the show grounds. Friday-Lunch and Dinner, Saturday-Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner, and Sunday-Breakfast and Lunch. As well as snack and drinks through the weekend.

Any youth staying on the grounds overnight must have an adult chaperone.

New Volunteer Requirement for 2021

Each exhibitor or family must provide at least one Volunteer for one hour during the show. A Google sign up will be sent out prior to the show with times that volunteers are needed. This show is run by volunteers only and we can never have too much help. We ask that you include the Volunteer name and contact information with your entry.

The South Central District would like to thank everyone for their cooperation. Remember, the show staff are all volunteers, working hard for all 4-H members!! The goals of the 4-H Horse Program are to develop leadership abilities, develop appreciation of horseback riding, learn skill in horsemanship, increase knowledge of safety precautions, promote a greater love of animals, learn to help others, and learn good sportsmanship. And they learn that from You!!!

Entries not postmarked by the April 17th deadline will incur a \$50 late registration fee. We will allow late entries up to the day of the show with the \$50 late fee.

Protest Rules

In order for the show committee to act, a verbal protest must be submitted immediately upon conclusion of the class. And a written and signed protest must be filed by the complaining party accompanied with a \$50.00 cash deposit within fifteen minutes of the conclusion of the class. If the appeals committee upholds the protest, the deposit shall be refunded. If the protest is overruled, the deposit shall be forfeited to the SCD 4-H Horse Program. These appeals and complaints must be directed by an exhibitor and/or spokesperson for the exhibitor and should be registered with the show committee. The show committee will serve as the appeals committee and act upon any protest. Eligibility of participants and horses cannot be protested.

When an exhibitor's parent or leader is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's right to participate in future classes and/or shows for a period deemed appropriate. The exhibitor's parent or leader can and will be barred from show grounds for unsportsmanlike conduct or any improper behavior.

All State entries must be postmarked 10 days following our District Show, which will be May 26th. Please pick up your state packet prior to leaving the Show.

No state show packets will be mailed.
