ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-ENTERED, NO POST ENTRIES

Please Read Carefully. Please be sure to include your email address on the Entry form. Horse show information and updates will be sent out only via email. One Horse/Rider Per Entry Form.

*ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED TO YOUR COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE BETWEEN MARCH 17 AND MARCH 31, 2023.

*Extension Staff will mail entries to the Wilson County Office by April 7th.

All Extension Staff mailing packets with a postmark after April 7th will be charged a LATE FEE of \$30.00 per entry*

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER a postmark date of April 14th.

You will NOT be able to add classes at the show. Please sign up for All Classes you intend to show at the time you register! This is in keeping with the State 4-H Horse Show Policy.* No Refunds will be given out without an MD and/or DVM note after April 21!

Pony Measurement

Measurement staff must measure all ponies in Junior & Senior Hunter classes before the show packet can be picked up.

Coggins

COGGINS WILL BE CHECKED WHILE ON SHOWGROUNDS AND COPY MUST BE POSTED ON STALL DOOR. (Must present a paper copy at check in!)

Eligibility Cards:

Must be completed and signed by EXTENSION AGENT for every horse/rider combination. Only submit a **COPY**, you must keep your original.

Dressage

Dressage ride times will be assigned. If you have any class conflicts with your time, please go to the paddock master before your ride time and let them know so you can get a different time. If you miss your ride time, you will NOT be assigned a new ride time!

Important Reminders:

- > All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted.
- > No cell phone use when mounted.
- > All western riders must show with a number displayed on each side of their saddle pad with the exception of the gaming division.
- > Warm-Up classes will run open card for all fence heights. Please notify the gate steward at the beginning of your division if you're completing a warmup round.

INFORMATION & RULES

- 1. Neither the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, Northeast District 4-H, Southeast District 4-H, or show hosts will be responsible for an accident that may occur to any animal, person, or property at this show. The exhibitors and spectators shall hold the management or owners or grounds as a hold harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from any accident that might occur.
- 2. The judges' decision shall be final. When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parents, leader, or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's rights to participate in future classes and/or shows for such a period of time as judged appropriate.
- 3. Rules from the North Carolina 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual will be followed. USEF, AQHA, AMHR, USDF, WDAA, and WHOA rules will be followed for their respective divisions not covered in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual.
- 4. Show management reserves the right to (a) combine, cancel or split classes depending on the number of entries and (b) disqualify from showing any horse or pony that is unmanageable, dangerous, or unsound and any youth who exhibits unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior.
- 5. Exhibitors will not be allowed to add classes at the show.
- 6. **Cloverbuds:** are defined as youth ages 5-7 as of January 1st of the current year. Cloverbud classes are non-competitive with no entry fee.
- 7. **Short Stirrup:** Riders must be ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year. Three years' participation in the division is allowed, with no more than 2 years' showing over fences. (Hunter Hack does not count towards the 2 years over fences and may be shown all 3 years.
- 8. **Rookie**: Riders in their first year of showing Hunt Seat as a Junior or Senior as of January 1st of the current year. Riders are permitted 1 year to show at this level.
- 9. **Long Stirrup**: Riders must be ages 14-18 as of January 1st of the current year. Two years of participation in the division is allowed. Riders in this division may not have previously shown over fences for more than 2 years.
- 10. <u>Little Britches</u>: Riders must be ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year, who are in their first 2 years of showing. Riders in this division cannot cross enter in the Junior Western or Junior Ranch Divisions.
- 11. Junior Riders: Youth who are ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year.
- 12. **Senior Riders**: Youth who are 14-18 as of January 1st of the current year and have <u>not</u> reached the age of 19 as of January 1st of the current year.
- 13. Open Warm Up Classes are non-qualifying classes for warm up over fences at rider's division height (2', 2'3", and 2'6") These classes may be used for Combined Training Qualification. Ring steward must be told in advance. These are open card and ridden with your division. You are limited to one warm-up class in your division.
- 14. Billy Murray (BM) Classes are non-qualifying classes for warm up and practice purposes Not open to Cloverbuds. Proceeds from entries in these classes support the Billy S. Murray Memorial Scholarship Fund of the SED4HHC.
- 15. The judge will place all classes through 10th place. However, the show will only give 1st-6th place ribbons.
- 16. Cross Rail Working Hunter Over Fences is a non-point class that is open to Juniors and Seniors, horses and ponies. Riders in this class may not cross-enter into any other working hunter or equitation over fences class. This class will be an introductory working hunter class to be performed at the canter over 18" cross rail fences only.

Qualifying Points: The following point system will be used in earning qualifying points toward attending the State 4-H Horse Show. Each exhibitor and horse must earn one or more qualifying points in each division to be eligible to participate in that division in the State Show. The number of horses in a class will be determined by the number shown. Under no circumstances shall a disqualified contestant receive points; however, each horse brought into the ring will constitute an entry and will be counted.

PRIZES TO THE TOP 5 CLUB/COUNTY WINNERS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All contestants need to sign up Friday at the Registration Desk by 8pm.
- 2. Stall decorations are based on craftsmanship, originality/creativity and maintenance throughout the entire affiliate's club stall area.
- 3. All stalls within the affiliate's area will be judged on cleanliness.
- 4. Stalls must be ready to be judged by Saturday morning at 10:00 a.m. Decorations must remain in place until noon on Saturday.
- 5. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - a. 40% on maintenance and cleanliness
 - b. 30% on originality/creativity
 - c. 30% on craftsmanship
- 6. Teams may use curtains. However, farm or stable curtain/decorations will not be eligible. Club or county name should be clearly posted on each stall to be judged for groups.
- 7. No decorations may be placed outside the barns.

I do hereby affirm and acknowledge that me and/or my child are participating in the Program for my and/or his/her own personal benefit, and that I am, and my child has been, fully informed of the inherent hazards and risk to me and them associated with this activity including property damage, health risks, falls, and other personal injuries, up to and including death. I accept and assume responsibility for all risks, known and unknown, involved to me and/or my child and my and/or their property in the aforementioned activity, and I voluntarily authorize my and/or my child's participation in reliance upon my own judgment and knowledge of my and/or child's experience and capabilities.

I understand that the determination of my child's ability to participate in the Program should be made by my child's physician if necessary, including being found by such physician to be in good health and fully able to perform all activities associated with the Program. I understand that I need the approval of a physician if I am uncertain as to his/her physical fitness for the rigors of this Program. I understand that I may be required to seek approval from a physician if there is a health or safety question relative to my child's condition before being allowed to participate in the Program. In addition, I give permission to any doctor, hospital, or other medical facility to release confidentially to the treating physician(s) for my child any information they may have concerning my medical condition(s) and their professional contact with him/her for treatment purposes. BILLY S. MURRAY, SR. 4-H HORSE PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND: Billy S. Murray, Sr. was a professional farrier and a long time 4-H leader and supporter in the Southeast District. Billy led 4-H horse clubs in both New Hanover and Brunswick counties. He was also an active member of several horse organizations in Southeastern NC, including the Carolina Classic Horsemen's Association, the Seagate Saddle Club, the Brunswick County and Columbus County Horsemen's Association. He was always willing to lend a hand and help out other horse owners and youth in a time of need. His sudden death came in September of 2005, after volunteering his time to announce an annual horse show in Wayne County. This scholarship was established to carry on Billy's tradition of supporting youth through 4-H horse activities.

PURPOSE: To assist high school seniors and graduates who are continuing their education by pursuing a two or four year college degree, and have been active 4-H members and participants of the Southeast or Northeast District 4-H Horse Program.

AWARD: A \$500 scholarship to one high school senior or graduate enrolling at a senior or community college. The award will be mailed directly to the college.
