NC PLT by the Numbers

24 Facilitators, representing 14 organizations, led 42 Workshops across the state

657 Educators trained

816 PLT Activity Guides distributed through workshops = **\$14,404** in support from NC Forestry Association

NC PLT partners contributed \$11,731 in material support of the program and \$15,029 in contributed time* to lead workshops; a total contribution of \$26,760 from statewide partners

21 K-8 workshops, **10** K-12 workshops, **7** Environmental Experiences for Early Childhood workshops, **4** High School workshops; the PLT flagship guide remains the most popular

10 workshops held at higher education institutions, 3 at Community Colleges7 workshops were specifically for K-12 teacher professional development2017 Goals

Continue to increase the function of the NC PLT Advisory Committee Continue to promote CFE Credits for registered foresters

Roll-out more online/blended workshops and e-Units from national PLT

Develop activity kits with the help of the NC PLT Student Intern
