CITs are expected to lead various activities based on topic(s) that he or she may be interested in sharing with the younger campers, and assist the staff with tasks pertinent to the Summer Fun program. The participants are held to high expectations. They are expected to meet the responsibilities given to them and set an example to the younger campers as well as their fellow peers.

The CIT Program is an exciting experience Union County 4-H Youth Development Program is pleased to introduce to the area teenagers. This program is ultimately about discovering what you are capable of, finding your inner leader, and creating a lasting experience.

There is a minimal cost of \$50 to participate in the program. This fee is due at the first training session in May. The fee helps reduce cost of program, training materials, and uniform. The deadline is April 6, 2018 at 5 p.m. Spaces are competitive and limited. 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Counselor-in-Training Program

Program Overview:

The Counselor-in-Training Program is designed to teach leadership, citizenship, and communication skills to teenagers, 14 years of age or older*. The program is a trained service learning opportunity that is defined by the following criteria: community service and an intensive training on leadership, behavior & conflict management, ages and stages of children, team building, and program planning. Each week, CITs will work alongside the 4-H Program Assistant and Summer Fun Interns to execute the programs and educate the younger children in a fun manner. As a part of their experience, CIT participants will be responsible for keeping a journal to document their experience, completing First Aid/CPR certification training hosted by the 4-H program, meeting periodically with 4-H staff, and completing the necessary trainings.

After training, the participants of the CIT program will be confident, more enthusiastic, and ready to educate the youth during the Summer Fun program.

Program Requirements:

- Participants must be 14 years of age or older*
- Commit to at least two weeks during a designated program week
- Completed Application
- Must pay a fee of \$50, which is due at first training session.
- Attend the two mandatory training sessions (May 18 & June 8)
- Notify 4-H Program Assistant or 4-H Agent if you will not able to work a scheduled day for a valid reason.
- Please do not sign up for a week that you know will conflict with already arranged schedule.

As a CIT, youth will:

- Be mentored by Leadership team
- Be a part of a day camp set up
- Document their experience
- Set and track goals
- Get to know other participants in his or her age group
- Help all participants to engage in the program experience
- Foster the purpose of 4-H
- Be a great role model
- Build lasting friendships
- Learn valuable 21st Century leadership skills
