JUNIOR BEEF HEIFER SHOW

The purpose of the Junior Beef Heifer Show is to provide youth an opportunity to exhibit their heifers in a local show. The following rules and regulations will be followed and conform to the rules for the Junior Beef Heifer Show at the North Carolina State Fair. Many of these heifers will be exhibited at the North Carolina State Fair.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR JUNIOR BEEF HEIFER SHOW

- 1. Open to youth exhibitors 8-19 (as of January 1, 2019) and North Carolina residents. Exhibitors should be part of the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit.
- 2. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) animals total (eg: 2 heifers or 2 steer or one steer and one heifer).
- 3. Exhibitors must have trained and fitted the animals from August 15, 2018. Ownership by exhibitors is not required. However, in cases where exhibitors do not own the animal, a certificate of training and fitting from the owner is required at entry time.
- 4. If an exhibitor has more than one entry per class, another junior exhibitor must show the additional animals. Adults are not eligible to show in youth classes.
- 5. Heifers must be halter broken. Unruly, unbroken, or dangerous animals will be asked to leave the ring.
- 6. All breeds will be shown in one class.
- 7. Classes will be divided based on age of heifer and will be announced on the day of the show.
- 8. Heifers will be shown Thursday, September 12, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Check in is from 3:30pm-5:30pm.

- 10. A Grand Champion and Reserve Champion heifer will be picked from the class winners.
- 11. All rules subject to change per show official's discretion. All decisions will be final.

- Class 6: Calved between March 1-April 30, 2018
- Class 7: Calved between January 1-February 28, 2018
- Class 8: Calved between September 1-December 31, 2017

JUNIOR BEEF STEER SHOW

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR JUNIOR BEEF STEER SHOW

- 1. Open to youth exhibitors 8-19 (as of January 1, 2019) and North Carolina residents. Exhibitors should be part of the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit.
- 2. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) animals total (ex: 2 heifers or 2 steer or one steer and one heifer).
- 3. Exhibitors must have trained and fitted the animals from August 15, 2018. Ownership by exhibitors is not required. However, in cases where exhibitors do not own the animal, a certificate of training and fitting from the owner is required at entry time.

- 4. Steers must weigh at least 800 pounds and can have two permanent teeth. All other teeth must be baby teeth and in place.
- 5. Steers must be halter broke and dehorned. Unruly, unbroken, or dangerous animals will be asked to leave the ring.
- 6. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries. If animals are in the same class, another junior must show his animal.
- Registration for the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship circuit will be online at richmond.ces.ncsu.edu, there you may indicate that you wish to show in the Lee County show. Please call 919-775-5624 for information or questions concerning the Lee County Show.
- 8. Classes will be divided by steer weights (light, middle and heavy). A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from the class winners.
- 9. Check-in: 3:30pm-5:30pm. Steers will be shown Thursday, September 12, 2019 immediately following the heifer show.
- 10. All rules subject to change per show official's discretion. All decisions will be final.

All show animals must be removed from the barn within one hour after conclusion of the show

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MEAT GOAT SHOW

- 1. Open to 4-H members between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18). Exhibitors must be registered with the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit.
- 2. Exhibitors limited to two (2) animals per type (eg: 2 wethers and 2 does) and one entry per class.
- 3. An official health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian or approved state or federally employed veterinarian must accompany animals and be available upon request. Sick or thin animals will not be accepted.
- 4. All goats must meet NCDA Scrapies regulations. Those animals that do not will be asked to leave the fairgrounds.
- 5. All participants are automatically entered in their respective showmanship classes.
- 6. Goats will be shown Wednesday, September 11, 2019 at 6:00pm. Wether weigh-in & doe check-in from 3:30pm-5:30pm.
- 7. Market goat classes (wethers) will be divided by weight as evenly as possible.
- 8. Classes arranged at the discretion of the show officials.
- 9. Classes divided into the weight classes an hour before the show for market goats.
- Registration for 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit will be online at <u>https://www.eventbrite.com/e/4-h-farm-credit-showmanship-circuit-tickets-63795852111</u> and you will indicate that you wish to register for the Lee County show. - 11. All youth ages 5-7 (Cloverbuds) will not be judged under competition, but will exhibit non-competitively and receive a participation ribbon and a \$5 premium.
- 12. Unruly, unbroken, or dangerous animals will be asked to leave the ring.
- 13. All rules subject to change per show official's discretion. All decisions will be final.

All show animals must be removed from the barn within 1 hour after conclusion of show

Note: Each exhibitor will only collect \$5 one time if they do not place 1^{a} , 2^{a} , or 3^{a} . Exhibitors who place 1^{a} , 2^{a} , or 3^{a} are not eligible for the \$5 participation prize.
