- * Non Point Class
- 1. Junior & senior riders compete in the same class.
- 2. Horses & ponies compete in the same class.
- 3. Must be plain shod with natural tail.
- 4. Determined by points.
- 5. Exhibitors age 5-8 as of January 1st.
- 6. Exhibitors 12 years of age or younger.
- 7. Entries to walk and jog.
- 8. Non-Competitive. No points or placings awarded.
- 9. English and Western compete together.
- 10. Must qualify at District show by placing 1st or 2nd in respective Equitation Over Fence Class for the Hunter Division (Restricted Classes do not count), or Western Horsemanship Class for the Western Division. Open only to non-trotting breeds.
- 11. Canter not allowed.
- 12. Walking, Racking, and Spotted Saddle Horses are ineligible for this class.
- 13. Must have completed a course of eight fences at respective district show to be eligible.
- 14. Only open to Saddleseat Trotting breeds
- 15. Non Trotting Division entries may only enter one pleasure class.
