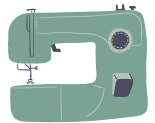

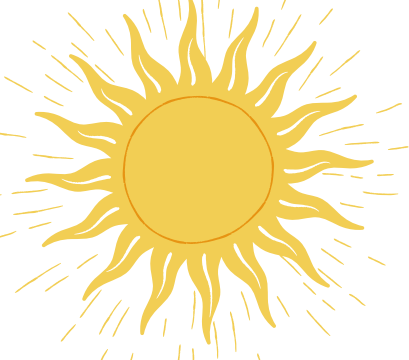

-Please note age/grade limitations for all classes. Participants must have COMPLETED KINDERGARTEN during the 2021-2022 school year to participate. Grades listed in workshop details are the grades youth were in for 2021-2022. Age is as of January 1.

-Space is limited! First come, first served!

-Registration is a 2-step process.

1. Complete the registration form and bring it by the extension office to register. Mailed in forms & payment will be accepted, unless class is already full. **PAYMENT IS DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION; NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT.**

2. Each youth participant MUST be enrolled as a "member" in 4-HOnline at v2.4honline.com no later than Friday, May 27 or your child will not be able to participate and registration fees will not be refunded.

-We can only accept cash or checks made out to CES.

-All fees are non-refundable unless the class is filled to capacity or is canceled.

-All classes are subject to cancellation due to lack of participation.

-A snack and drink will be provided at each class.

-All classes will meet at the Rowan County Cooperative Extension office. Parents/Guardians will enter the main lobby to drop off their child and will return to pick them up at the conclusion of the class.

-Rowan County Cooperative Extension, its staff, and its volunteers are NOT responsible for sunburn or insect bites. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for applying protective agents prior to each class.

-All classes will operate under the 4-H Code of Conduct.
