2. How old were you when you were in 4-H?
3. Where did you live when you were in 4-H?
4. How did you become involved in 4-H?
5. What major events were going on in the world when you were in 4-H?
6. How was life different when you were a kid?
7. What projects & activities did you do when you were in 4-H?
8. What was your favorite project/activity? Why was that your favorite?
9. Tell me about your 4-H Club.
10. Did you attend 4-H Camp? If so, tell me about your experiences at 4-H Camp.
11. Did you attend 4-H Congress (formerly known as Club Congress)? If so, tell me about your experiences at Congress.
12. Did you serve as an officer in 4-H? If so, what positions did you hold?
13. What kinds of community service activities or volunteering did you do?
14. Who was one of the most influential people in your 4-H career, and why?
15. What experiences did you have in 4-H that you otherwise wouldn't have had?
16. Is there anything you did in 4-H that you didn't really enjoy at the time, but are glad you did now? If so, what?
17. What opportunities are there in 4-H now that weren't available when you were in 4-H?
18. What was one of the most important skills you learned in 4-H?
19. What is one of your favorite memories from your time in 4-H?
