About us: The Kenan Farm, a block of farmland that sits just off Groometown Road in Guilford County a few miles outside Greensboro, NC, has been in our family for nearly 60 years and for most all of those years, that land has harvested a variety of crops every spring, summer and fall. Having already raised tobacco on that land for 31 years... 21 years that James worked with his father "Sprunt" and 10 that he and I had worked the land after his father passed away... we decided we wanted to live as close as we could to the crops we raised. So in 1980, with the help of some ever-faithful friends, James began to build our log cabin on a small piece of the land in the middle of where he and his father had farmed all those years together. Situated on the hill just above the lake we use for irrigation, James and his friends spent the next three years, little by little, building our cozy log cabin and in 1983 we were finally able to call that cabin our new home. It was also in that spring of 1983 that another "new" venture for the Kenan family began... the road towards what we now know as "Bernie's Berries"!
