1. Copy of Notarized Medical Release Form (2 pages) for current year which is on file with your county agent for 2016
2. Copy of current 12 month negative Coggins Test for Equine Infectious Anemia (current through last day of show) (Horse's name must match that on entry form)

****Note: The horse's name must be the same on all components of the entry including Entry Form and Coggins Test. In addition, there must have been an eligibility card submitted by the March 1 deadline with the same horse and rider combination listed. ****

Completed entry forms and fees must reach the Extension Horse Husbandry Office postmarked by June 10, 2016. Entries will not be accepted postmarked after June 10, 2016.
