### Position Description/Responsibilities:

Works with Extension Agents and program and office staff to coordinate and implement hands-on, educational program events and activities. Participates in meetings where local issues are identified and prioritized, and program results and plans are discussed. Assists in preparations for planned events and activities by gathering information, assembling materials, contacting participants, and soliciting support from external sources. As appropriate, conducts the teaching, training, or other program presentations.

The intern will also assist in the development, taping and editing of educational videos to enhance the audience reached through Cooperative Extension marketing and media efforts.
