Position Description/Responsibilities:

The summer intern will work with our 4-H agents and Agriculture Agents to plan, implement and evaluate a strong summer program for the youth in Guilford County. They will assist with our summer fun program which includes several day camps, overnight camp at Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Center, and one-day trips.

We also could use an intern to assist with the livestock and dairy shows as well as the dairy calf project.

Intern will work~ 8 hours/week with our Community and School Garden Agent.

Duties could include:

- Attending site visits to community and school gardens in Guilford County with the agent
- Preparing materials for and participating in the Family Summer Gardening Program, co-led by the Agent and Greensboro Parks and Recreation
- Preparing materials for and attending school garden summer training (2-3 during the summer), community garden workshops (1-2 during the summer)
- Revising and updating the public database of community gardens in Guilford County

Preferred qualifications/previous coursework:

- Desire to work with youth and be a team player
- Previous experience working with groups of children is desired
- Should also have good organization, time management, and project planning skills

- The intern will have the opportunity to work with agents in all program areas

- Will also have an opportunity to develop lessons in their own area of expertise
- Will learn all aspects of Cooperative Extension and gain experience in planning, implementing, and evaluating programs
