Position Description/Responsibilities:

An intern would have the opportunity to learn all areas of Extension and have the benefit of working with each of the Extension Agents and County Extension Staff member.

Depending on COVID, our programs will hopefully begin to be restored and off to meeting face to face again. The 4-H Summer Program hopes to begin to offer face to face programming with opportunities to teach and assist in the programs. The intern will work with 4-H Summer Programs and other opportunities.

We host youth summer interns that direct and assist in the summer classes and the opportunities for leadership development and teambuilding activities.

Our office is responsible for running the Nash County Farmers Market and in the summer months, the market is open on Saturdays and one other day of the week. The intern would be asked to assist with market activities and events as the schedule allows.

Agriculture Agents work with farmers trouble shooting and the intern would have an opportunity to work with Agriculture Agents in the field exploring the farming world.

The Family and Consumer Science Agent teaches many food and nutrition programs and provides food demonstrations at the senior center, faith based organizations, community centers, and farmers market in which the intern could assist.

Our Community and Rural Development Extension Agent directs a Teen Leadership Camp each summer and the intern could work to assist this camp as well as learn the other areas of community development.

Preferred qualifications/previous coursework:

Interest in working with youth; agriculture; foods and nutrition, public relations; and government resources.

Benefits/skills student will gain through this internship:

- The intern will receive well balanced experiences to understanding the variety of Extension programs and how we work, partner, and collaborate to meet the needs of the community.
- Intern will be exposed to local government, our Extension advisory councils, and how these partnerships tie together for the betterment of Nash County citizens.
- Intern will learn the different aspects of program planning and evaluation.
