Position Description/Responsibilities:

Depending on the interest of the intern, this project can encompass a wide variety of assignments to give the intern a comprehensive understanding of the work of Cooperative Extension in Orange County. Projects can range from working with children through our summer 4-H youth camps to working with farmers at the Breeze Farm Incubator to apply sustainable horticultural and agronomic practices on working farms.

The intern can learn how to develop business plans with farmers, assist with livestock projects, teach youth how to show animals, assist with plant diagnostics, assist with database development for local farm products, design and implement cooking classes, perform general community outreach, and more.

Depending upon the situation this summer with COVID-19, we anticipate that this individual will help us with developing virtual programs and take-home 4-H activity kits and strengthening current virtual initiatives.

The successful applicant will be expected to be an active part of our team this summer.

Depending upon the nature of the project, the intern may work independently at times as well.
