Position **Description/Responsibilities:**

The summer intern will work primarily with the Family & Consumer Sciences (FCS) Extension Agents to support programming in the areas of nutrition, cooking, food safety, food systems, and financial literacy. They will assist with the complete program delivery process, including planning, preparation, implementation, and evaluation.
