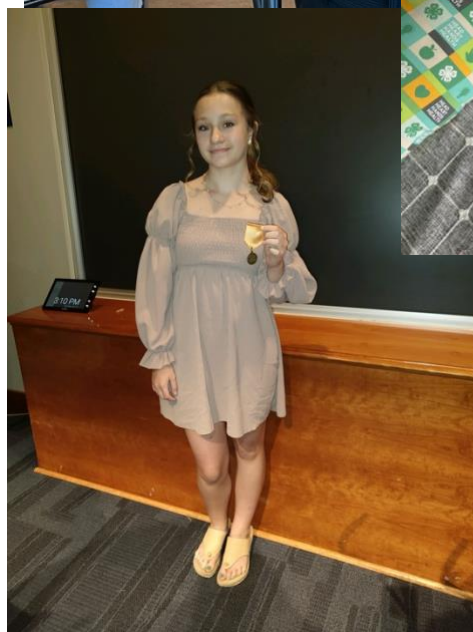

4-H Summer Adventures and Camps

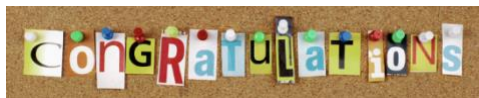
